


spring Art Week

Spring Art Week is a Grand Valley tradition in its 37th year, where area students can observe professional working artists as they create, explain their process, and inspire students. Spring Art Week is a one- or two-hour demonstration program for grades preK-12. Everyone is invited: public schools, private schools, special education, and home school. There are eight stations: Blacksmithing, Institute of Dancing Art, Blowing Glass, Interdisciplinary Art Drawing (Hands-on), Writing a Storybook, Polynesian Cultural Art Presentation, Illustration (Hands-on), and Clay Wheel Throwing.

The cost is \$40 per class for one hour (four stations), or \$75 for two hours (all eight stations). Each one-hour session includes four of the eight artist stations.

Home school, private school, and special needs groups are also encouraged to attend.



Registration Form

Spring Art Week is a program designed to educate and inspire children in the arts. Students visit stations where professional artists demonstrate their art forms while interacting with the students. Students come away with a basic understanding of various arts, media and techniques, as well as an appreciation for art professions. Spring Art Week also provides teachers with ideas for art projects that can be explored with the children in the classroom.

Please complete one of these forms for each group of children. If you are bringing more than one group of students and would like all of them to come at the same time, please indicate this on each of the forms. Forms that are not completely filled out will be returned for completion.

The cost is \$40 per one-hour group or \$75 per two-hour group and is non-refundable. No time slot can be reserved without payment.

The program lasts one hour and showcases four different types of art processes.

There are 8 different programs to choose from and four time slots each hour.

Time slots and programs are assigned on a first come first serve basis. Sign up early to increase your chances of getting the set and time that you want.

The recommended group size is 20 children with a recommended maximum of 25.

Be sure to arrive at least 10 minutes ahead of tour time so we can stay on schedule. Please note

that groups that arrive late may miss one or more of their stations so that the other groups stay on schedule. Be sure to let Art Center Staff know of any special circumstances regarding your group.

Curricula will be given to each teacher at the end of the tour, allowing you to take the ideas presented at The Art Center to the next level in your classrooms.
